The one night of the troubled spring of the dramatic year 2014 that saved Kharkiv from the tragic fate of Donetsk, Luhansk, many and many Donbas towns and villages, which endure now the seventh year of devastation by the separatists and Russian mercenaries.

Arsen Avakov tells about the events of the night 7 to 8 of April 2014 in Kharkiv in which he participated as head of ATO in the Kharkiv Oblast and immediate manager of the liberation of the Kharkiv Oblast State Administration, captured by the separatists.

In this book, his co-authors are Kharkiv residents, each telling there personal story of those troubled days.

The distinctive feature of this book is that the reader can listen to the audio recording of the separatists conversations using included QR codes. They provide undeniable and shocking evidence of criminal plans to capture Kharkiv and other large cities, to kill people, and to ruin Ukraine,

The author received special permission from the investigation to publish these documents.

This book is a living history of events: the chronicles, facts, documents, direct speech. It also includes an analysis and synthesis, the author's philosophical reflections on events in Kharkiv and the whole country, the future, the fate of Ukraine and its people.
