



Stephen Crane (1871—1900) is an American poet, prosaist, a newspaper reporter, representative of the school of impressionism in literature. Throughout his short life (he died before reaching the age of thirty), he created six novels, two books of verse, more than a hundred stories and sketches. In his writing Stephen Crane describes reality in the terms of a wellknown triad: a lone person, indifferent universe and a feeling of confrontation arising between them. He exerted great influence not only on the culture of the English-speaking countries but also on the generations to come of the poets, novelists and short story writers of other countries of the world. The collection comprises some of the non-adapted bestknown stories by Stephen Crane which entered the gold reserves of American literature.
